Encouraged by friends in the Livery and the City, and with the support of the Master, Wardens and Court of the Worshipful Company of Actuaries, I offer myself as a candidate for the High Office of Sheriff of the City of London at the election at Common Hall on Monday 24th June 2013. I invite you to use one of your votes to support me, and the other for Alderman Sir Paul Judge.

Born in Lancashire in 1950, and educated at Mount St Mary's College, Yorkshire and Royal Holloway College at the University of London, I became a liveryman in 1987, and served as Master Actuary in 2009/2010. I am Chairman of The Power of Ten, the Masters' Association for 2009/2010.

Having qualified as an actuary in Liverpool in 1975, I was a partner in Duncan C Fraser & Co from 1977 to 1986, including four years in Kuala Lumpur during which time I served as President of the Actuarial Society of Malaysia. I am a founder partner of Barnett Waddingham LLP in 1989 whose head office is in Cheapside, and which has become the largest independent firm of actuaries in the UK.

During my career I have played an active role in several professional associations serving as Chairman, including the International Association of Consulting Actuaries, and membership of the Occupational Pensions Joint Working Group which liaises with Ministers and government departments on pension policy. I was appointed as a CBE in the Birthday Honours 2012 for services to the pensions and actuarial professions.

My public service includes a governorship of the Pensions Policy Institute; a Director of the Epilepsy Society and a trustee of the Skeletal Cancer Action Trust. I am an underwriting member of Lloyd's, and a member of the Reform Club, the Association of Lancastrians in London, the Society for the Protection of Ancient Buildings and the cycling charity Sustrans. My City interests include membership of the City Livery Club, the Ward of Cheap, Bread Street and Broad Street Ward Clubs. I am a Friend of HQS Wellington.

Angela, my wife of forty years, is a Freeman of the Educators' Company and familiar with the ways of the City. Angela is wholeheartedly supporting my candidature. We have three children: Robert is a Director at NM Rothschild, Elizabeth is a Chartered Accountant with Blick Rothenberg, and Edward is researching epidemiology at Imperial College.

Having worked in the financial sector in London and been involved in the livery for over 25 years, I believe I am well qualified to support the Lord Mayor and the civic team, and to serve the Livery as Sheriff. The City has been good to me throughout my career and I would welcome now the opportunity to give my full time and energy to further its best interests. I would serve to the best of my ability.
